As a resident of the area and the city of Sammamish for 34 years, I don't agree with the current EIS scope as it focuses primarily on traffic concurrency. The EIS will be used to determine changes to our City's comprehensive plan and will have significant impacts on all of us living in Sammamish. The transparency in the process is not obvious, comments submitted do not appear to be addressed and why no public hearings?

The EIS does not address the lack of affordable housing or the impact of greenhouse gas emissions. We need transportation options that substantially reduce vehicle miles traveled.

The city should hold at least two public hearings at a minimum on the Draft BLUMA EIS (DEIS) at separate City Council meetings. Study sessions, planning commission meetings followed by public hearings before the City Council even considers the draft documents would be a more appropriate approach.
