I. JOINT STIPULATION

This Joint Stipulation is filed by Applicant King County ("County") and City of Sammamish ("City") who stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Shoreline Substantial Development Permit ("SSDP") 2016-00414 for the East Lake Sammamish Trail ("ELST") and Inglewood Parking Lot and SSDP 2016-00415 for ELST Segment B include similar trail design issues. The Hearing Examiner held an open public hearing on SSDP 2016-00415 and heard testimony from King County Parks Director Kevin Brown ("Director Brown") on November 3, 2017, regarding King County's Regional Trail System. 4 regional trails for both SSDPs, the testimony and exhibits referred to in Section 1 are relevant to
5 the Hearing Examiner's decision on the Inglewood Parking Lot, SSDP 2016-00414 and therefore
6 the testimony and exhibits should be entered into the hearing record. The City and County agree
7 that this would save time during the hearing and save the expense of having public employee
8 Director Brown testify to the same information.


9 3. The City and County ask the Hearing Examiner to accept this stipulation and




II. AGREED ORDER
