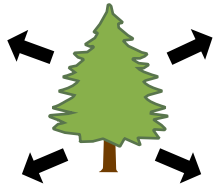
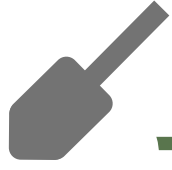


TREE PLANTING



STEP 1: LOCATION

Find a spot where the roots have room to spread and branches can grow away from building foundations, walls, decks, windows or powerlines.

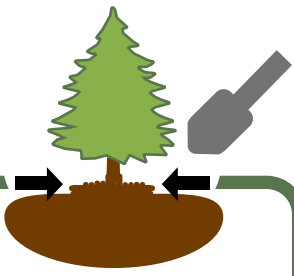
STEP 2: DIG A HOLE

The hole should be as deep as the root ball, and two times as wide.



STEP 3: REMOVE

Take the tree out of the container and place it in the hole. The top of the root ball should be level with the ground.



STEP 4: FILL IT IN

Fill the hole with dirt all the way up to the soil line. Gently pat down the soil to remove air pockets.



STEP 5: WATER

Water the tree and add 2-inch layer of mulch around the base. Continue to water regularly for 3 years, until the plant is well-established.
